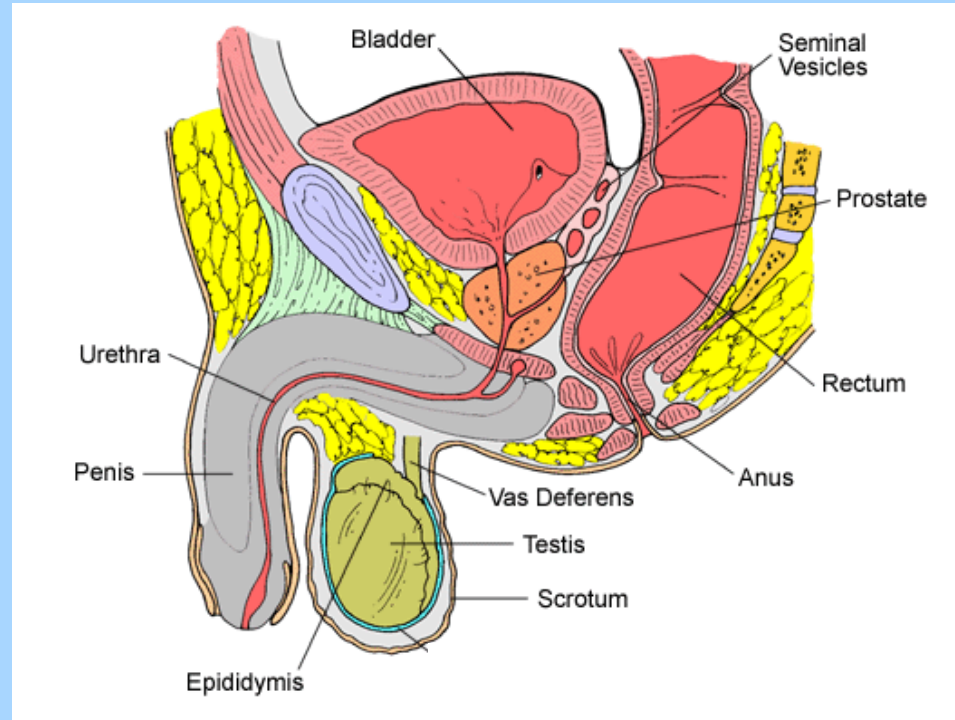
Male Reproductive Organs



The following images are a cross section...if a male was standing sideways looking toward the left (similar to the picture)

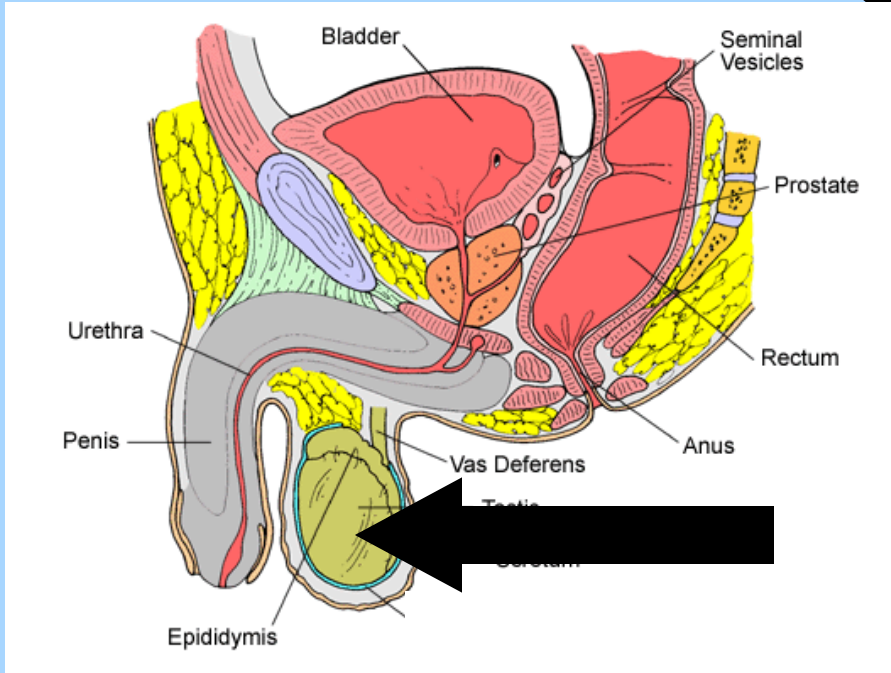
External Reproductive Organs

External Organs (genitals) include the penis, scrotum and testicles

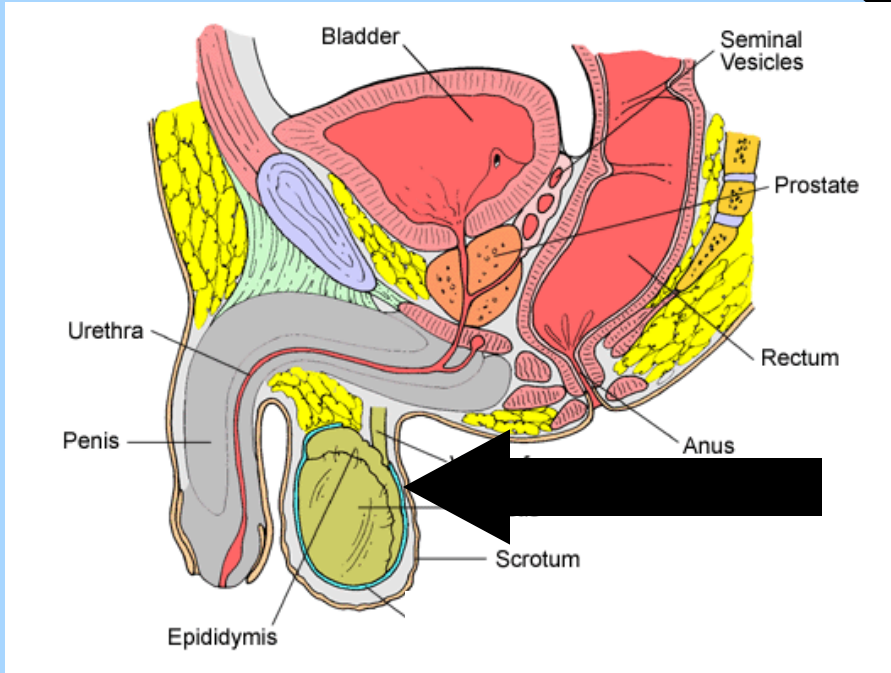
External Reproductive Organs



Teste S

Testes – produce the male sex cells
(sperm) & male sex hormone
(testosterone)

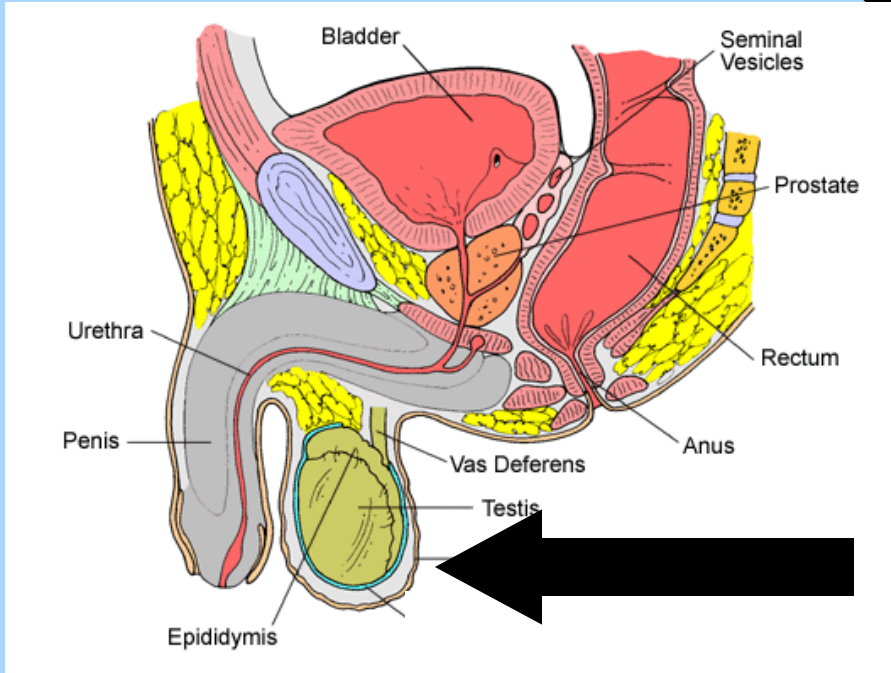
External Reproductive Organs



Epididymis

Epididymis – a coiled tube where the sperm cells mature

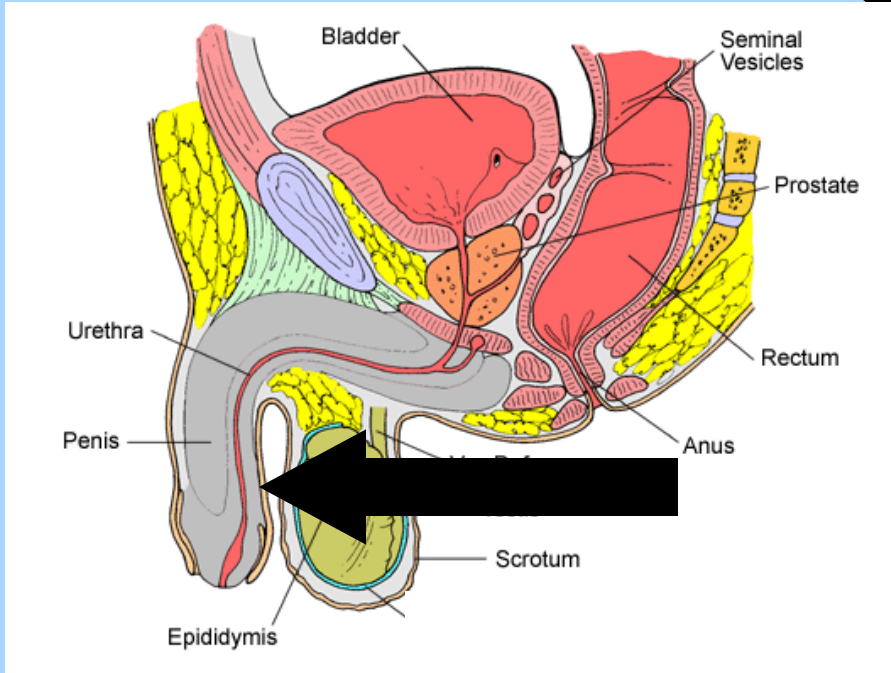
External Reproductive Organs



Scrotum

Scrotum – a loose pouch of skin that houses the testes, located below the penis

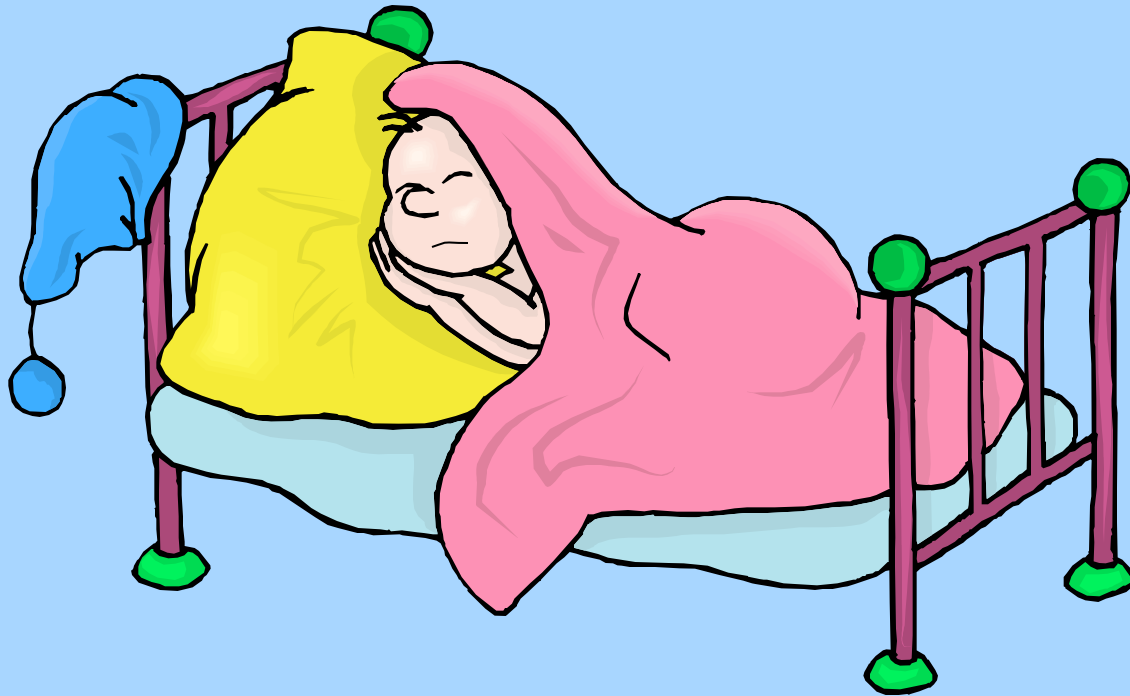
External Reproductive Organs



Penis

Penis – male reproductive organ, also used to urinate

Nocturnal Emission



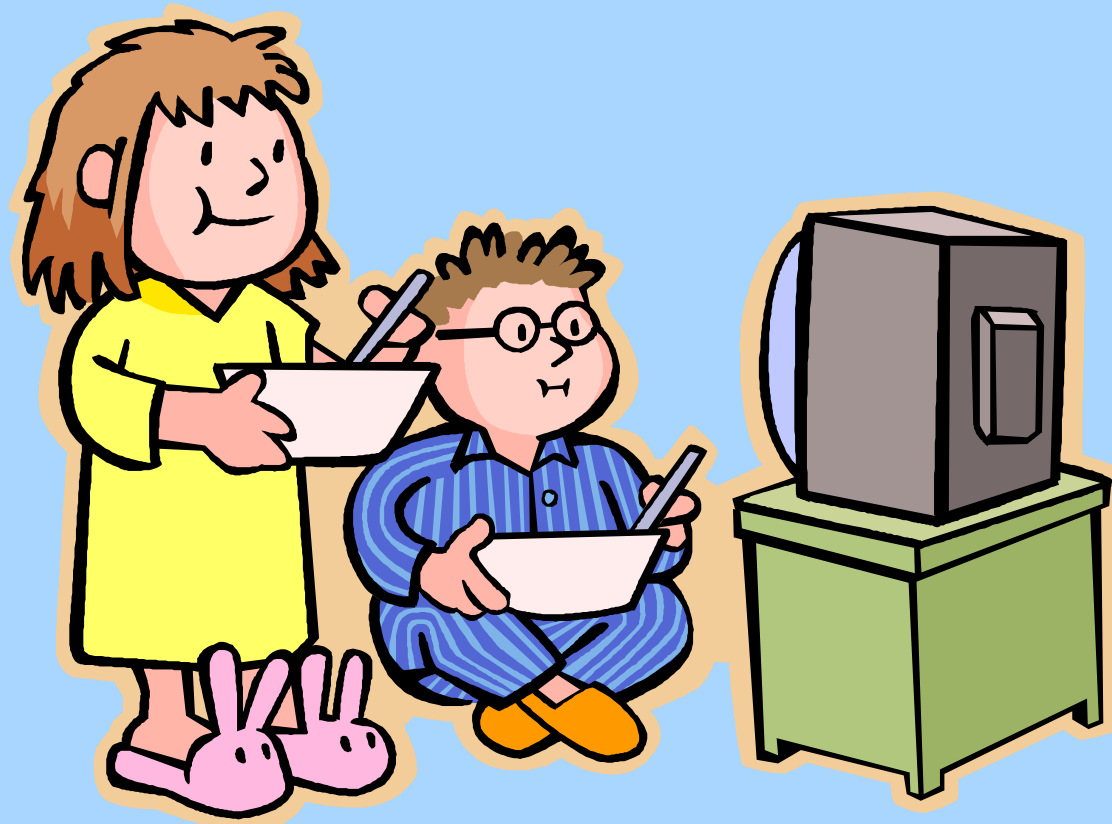
An involuntary ejaculation that usually occurs at night during sleep
